## **10. INSURANCE**

By endorsing the application form for entry the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider or passenger is insured in accordance with the UEM requirements. The organizer has contracted a third party insurance in accordance with the AMZS Sporting Code. The organizer disclaims all responsibility for damage of a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

## **11. PROTESTS AND APPEALS**

Any person or group of people - rider, passenger, entrant, manufacturer, official, etc., recognised by the UEM and concerned by a decision taken under the authority of the UEM, may ask for redress for the consequences of that decision

Generally, protests against the eligibility of a rider, passenger, entrant or a motorcycle entered, must be made before the start of the first official practice. Protests against results must be presented to the International Jury within 30 minutes following the announcement of the results. An appeal may be made against a decision of the International Jury to the International Disciplinary Court (CDI).

All protests to the International Jury must be made in accordance with the requirement of the Disciplinary and Arbitration Code of the UEM and be accompanied by a fee of 150.-€ or (equivalent amount in local currency) returnable if the protest is justified.

The deposits in case of dismantling and reassembling a machine following a protest, are as follows: € 350,-- for a 2-stroke engine (material included), € 600,-- for a 4-stroke engine (material included).

These amounts are paid to the team that presented a bike in conformity with the Alpe Adria Technical Rules or repaid to the protester. All requests for fuel control following a protest must be accompanied by a deposit of € 1.000,-- paid to the Jury or the UEM (in case of supplementary controls).

## **12. ENVIRONMENTAL DIRECTIONS:**

According to the FMNR Environmental rules. the use of an environmental mat is compulsory.
